Joint Qualification for Vocational Education and Training (VET) centres in the Field of Cultural Tourism - CULTVET'

In recent years, cultural tourism is the spearhead of any efforts for the diversification of the tourism offer particularly to overcome the seasonality of the «sea and sun» model. CultVET, a 2-year-long project, is aiming to contribute to the further growth of the tourism sector through the development of a **European Joint Qualification** for VET centres in the cultural tourism field, with a strong work-based component.

CultVET project main output:

Qualification Profile: Definition of a detailed qualification profile based on the European Hospitality Tourism Skills Passport and with the input of focus groups that took place in each partner's country.

Assessment standards: Are going to be designed for all the learning outcomes and project facilities and are going to include both classroom training activities and work-based learning.

Joint curriculum: Through the creation of a working group and in close collaboration with stakeholders the formed joint curriculum is describing specific competencies that learners need to acquire.

Quality Assurance mechanisms: Admission Criteria, Admission Management, Cooperation Agreement, Quality Criteria for the work-based learning component, Capacity Building for SMES, Communication Platform, Communication Protocols, Apprenticeship Training Plan, Training Logbook
